Definition: Guided practice is a teaching practice pioneered by Barbara Rogoff. It involves three steps for practicing new skills in the classroom. First, the teacher models how to do a task to the student. Second, the student does the task with guidance from the teacher.

Guided Instruction and Practice | Janine Schaub

“The critical stage in the model [Gradual Release of Responsibility] is ‘guided practice,’ the stage in which the teacher gradually releases task responsibility to the students.” (Pearson & Gallagher, 1983). Guided Practice is the transition phase, where children take more control of their learning and the teacher slowly steps back.

Guided Practice: In this part of the lesson, the students become involved. Guided practice means though, that you as teacher are involved in helping students put into practice what they've learned. Often this section will involve some kind of group or cooperative learning activities.

Basics of Lesson Plans - San Jose State University

Dictating a sentence for students to write is a great way to practice sight words, spelling patterns, and writing conventions (spacing, capital letters, periods). At the end of a guided reading lesson, have students write a sentence (preferably one that's related to the text and includes at least one sight word they're working on).

For example, instead of working on an entire essay, students in a guided practice might be instructed to work on a single body paragraph or perhaps the introduction.
